Behind The Chair is a good source for salon jobs throughout the USA and Canada. Jobs can be searched by location or category, and categories include a wide range of positions in addition to esthetician jobs, including makeup artist, nail tech, receptionist, store manager, and multiple jobs in the field of hair care and hairstyling. Job seekers can also fill out a profile for potential employers to search.

Filled with classified ads from a host of businesses, this site has salon/spa/fitness job boards listed under various cities.

## DAYSPAASSOCIATION.COM

The Day Spa Association serves as a resource for day spa professionals through educational seminars and workshops, research studies, publications, and Internet information exchanges. Spa employers can email their vacancies to the Day Spa Association Employment Bank. Also, each year the association recognizes an individual who has made a significant contribution to the spa industry. Applicants can apply for this position. The site also has a classified section that advertises investor services and office space.



The Global Hospitality website advertises international job openings, and has offices in Los Angeles and Toronto. The company specializes in recruiting for senior-level management positions in hotels, resorts, spas, and other hospitality settings worldwide.

Hand and Stone franchise locations offer facials, massage, waxing, and some other skin care services such as microdermabrasion. Their website lists current vacancies in these positions as well as management and front desk jobs.

Thousands of hospitality jobs are listed free on this site. It is a large database of fresh hospitality career opportunities. You can search for jobs both within the United States and overseas. They are classified under both management jobs and non-management jobs.


# HOSPITALITYONLINE.COM

This website gives long lists of jobs available in the U.S. hospitality industry. Applicants can browse by job title or location, and you can also post your resume for potential employers to search. Both hourly jobs and management jobs are advertised.

### JOBVERTISE.COM

Jobvertise has job listings, and you can post a resume free of charge. To look for spa jobs, scroll down to "Complete List of Jobs by Title," click on one letter, and type your field of employment. For example, if you are an esthetician, click on "E" and type in "esthetician."

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# MASSAGEENVYCAREERS.COM

National franchise Massage Envy added facials to its service menu several years ago. At its career website, you can search for vacancies by city, state, zip code, or job title, and apply online. Positions available are esthetician, massage therapist, sales/customer service, and management.

### ONESPAWORLD.COM

Spa careers aboard cruise ships begin at this website, run by Steiner, the world's largest operator of spas at sea. Steiner hires estheticians, hairstylists, massage therapists, nail technicians, personal trainers, and other salon and fitness professionals for 25 major cruise lines worldwide.

To be considered, estheticians must hold CIDESCO or equivalent certification, be qualified to use galvanic and faradic current, have at least 150 hours of massage training, have no visible tattoos, and be able to pass a medical exam and background check.

The hiring process is lengthy. Successful applicants must travel to London, England at their

own expense for up to two months of companyspecific training before being assigned to a ship. Assignments may be to any cruise line in any part of the world, so a valid passport is required.

Shipboard assignments are typically nine months in length, with shared accommodation and meals provided. Salary is based on commission.

# SALONEMPLOYMENT.COM

This website lists jobs under different fields including colorists, corporate managers, educators, estheticians, front desk/reception, massage therapists, and salon assistants.

Both recruiters and job applicants can join, as this website helps both sides of the employment process. The site is free to use for job seekers. Employers pay \$25 to advertise job vacancies or search for candidates.

# SPATRADE.COM

The SpaTrade website is maintained by *American Spa* magazine. Click on "Jobs" to view the current listings.

## SPAWIRE.COM

Employers can post job openings at the SpaWire Career Board, and job seekers can respond directly to the contact person listed within each job posting. The site is free for job seekers and charges a small fee for employers to post an ad.

## WAYSPA.COM/EN/JOBS

WaySpa is based in Canada and partners with several thousand spas in Canada, the USA, and worldwide to provide gift cards and other marketing opportunities. Affiliated spas advertise their open positions on the group's website, and job seekers can respond to advertisements through a form on the website.

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
